What has been accomplished? Last year's Pontifical Good Friday Collection:

- ♦ Supported 23 parishes and three academic institutions
- Provided a home in Bethlehem for 30 children from homes facing domestic violence
- ♦ Offered more than 500 scholarships for university education
- ♦ Helped keep school open for over 10,000 pre-K through grade 12 students
- ♦ Supported 53 friars preparing for the priesthood
- ♦ Restored and maintained 640 houses/apartments for Christian families
- Provided assistance to more than 9,000 families through weekly food baskets
- ♦ Employed more than 1,000 workers in the Holy Land
- ♦ Preserved 80 shrines from the life of Jesus, the Apostles and the prophets
- ♦ Construction of a Catholic School in Cana of Galilee, to give a Christian education to the youth of the city
- ♦ Began the work of restoration of the floor at the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher, the holiest place on Earth and
- ♦ completed the restoration of the Basilica of the Nativity, done for the 1st time in centuries
