At this event Priests will explain all the aspects, components, and rituals of The Holy Mass.

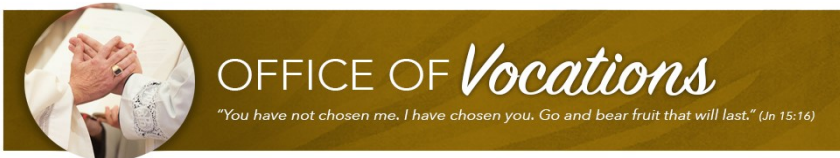
